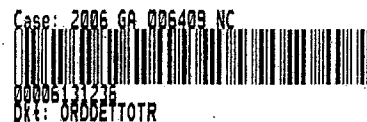
ORDER DETERMINING TOTAL INCAPACITY

On the Petition To Determine Incapacity filed by Denise Konstenius, Agent for Kensington Manor, the Court having considered the pleadings, including the Examining Committee reports, and all the alternatives to guardianship, and being fully advised, finds, based on the clear and convincing evidence presented, as follows:

1. The nature and scope of the Ward's incapacities are: as set forth in the Examining Committee reports, all of which are incorporated herein by reference;
2. The following facts demonstrate the Alleged Incapacitated Person is totally without capacity to care for his person or property: as set forth in the Examining Committee reports, all of which are incorporated herein by reference;
3. The Alleged Incapacitated Person totally lacks capacity to make informed decisions about care and treatment or to meet the essential requirements for his physical or mental health or safety; is subject to total legal disability; is incapable of exercising any rights; and a guardian must exercise all delegable rights of the Alleged Incapacitated Person and have full powers and duties with respect to him and his person and property;
4. After consideration of reasonable alternatives to guardianship, the Court finds no alternative will sufficiently address the Alleged Incapacitated Person's problems and needs;
5. Other than those rights set forth in Section 744.3215(1), Florida Statutes, which are expressly reserved to the Alleged Incapacitated Person, he is not capable of exercising any other rights and all delegable rights should be delegated to a plenary guardian. Accordingly, it is

ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Helen Woichowski is hereby determined to be totally incapacitated and a plenary guardian should be appointed to provide for his welfare and safety; and
