Dear Mr. Adams and Ms. Sinphay,

I am the court appointed attorney representing Helen Woichowski, the grandmother of Dana Guarscio.

It is my understanding that you are two attorneys involved in the criminal prosecution and defense of Dana Guarscio.

Please be advised that on February 28, 2007, my client, Helen Woichowski, called me and told me that she was very upset to learn that Dana was arrested, (at the time I did not know she had been arrested), and that I should be aware that Dana never financially abused her. Helen told me that she voluntarily gave Dana her money. Helen definitely does not want her granddaughter prosecuted. Helen loves her granddaughter and would do anything for her. Helen wanted to help Dana and she still does.

Helen sounded very sincere when talking to me and although she could not remember the details concerning giving money to Dana, she was very adamant in expressing her opinion that Dana never exploited her. She used the word "exploited" continuously in our conversation.

Of course, as you know, Helen Woichowski, was declared to be totally incapacitated on October 18, 2006. A copy of the Order is enclosed herewith for your immediate reference.

Because of Helen Woichowski's strong desire that I act on her request to help her granddaughter,

Dana Guarscio, I felt compelled to send this letter.
